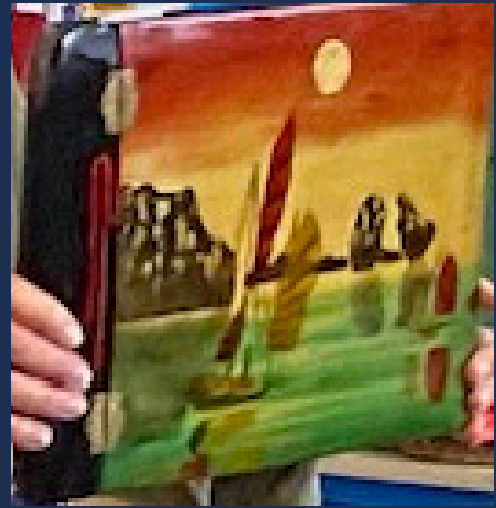


DECOUVERTE du Vietnam

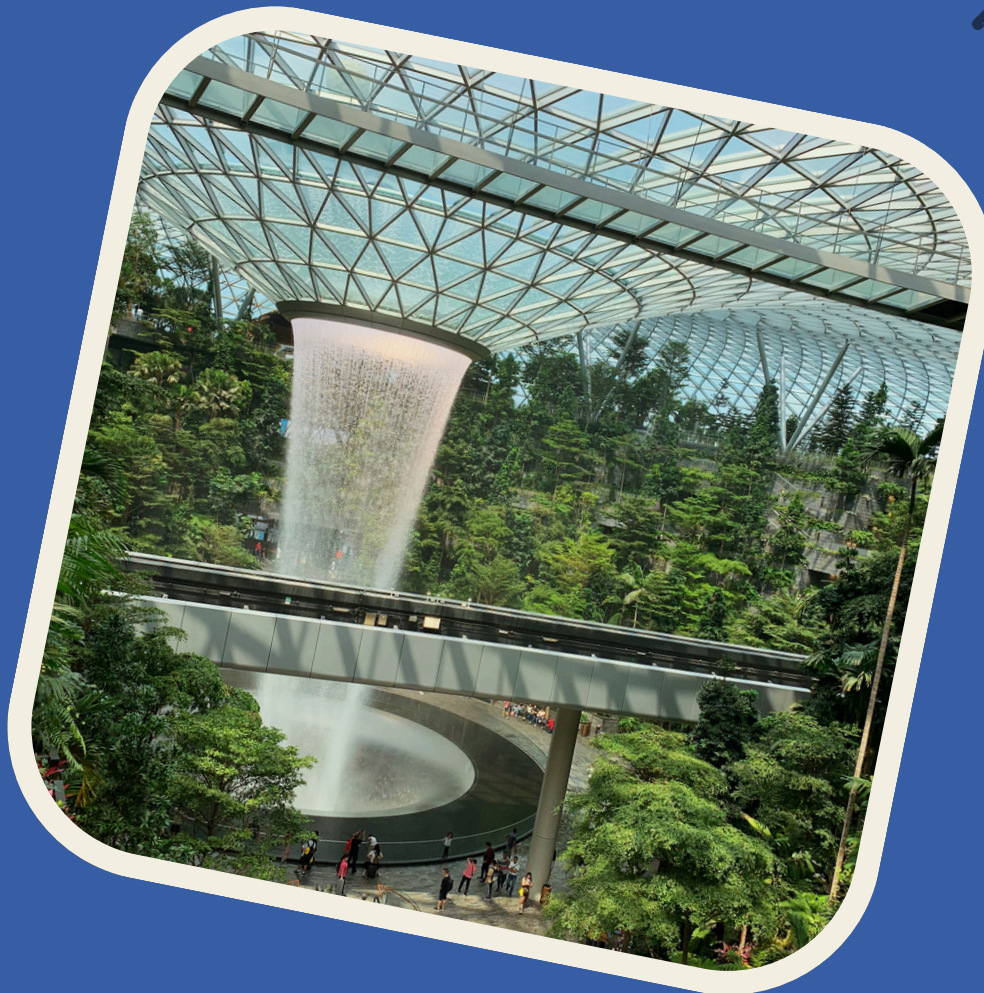
The street food in Myeongdong was unforgettable! I tried tteokbokki (spicy rice cakes), Korean fried chicken, and sweet hotteok pancakes.

Everything was so clean, and people were polite and respectful. Tokyo is a place where tradition and technology live side by side.

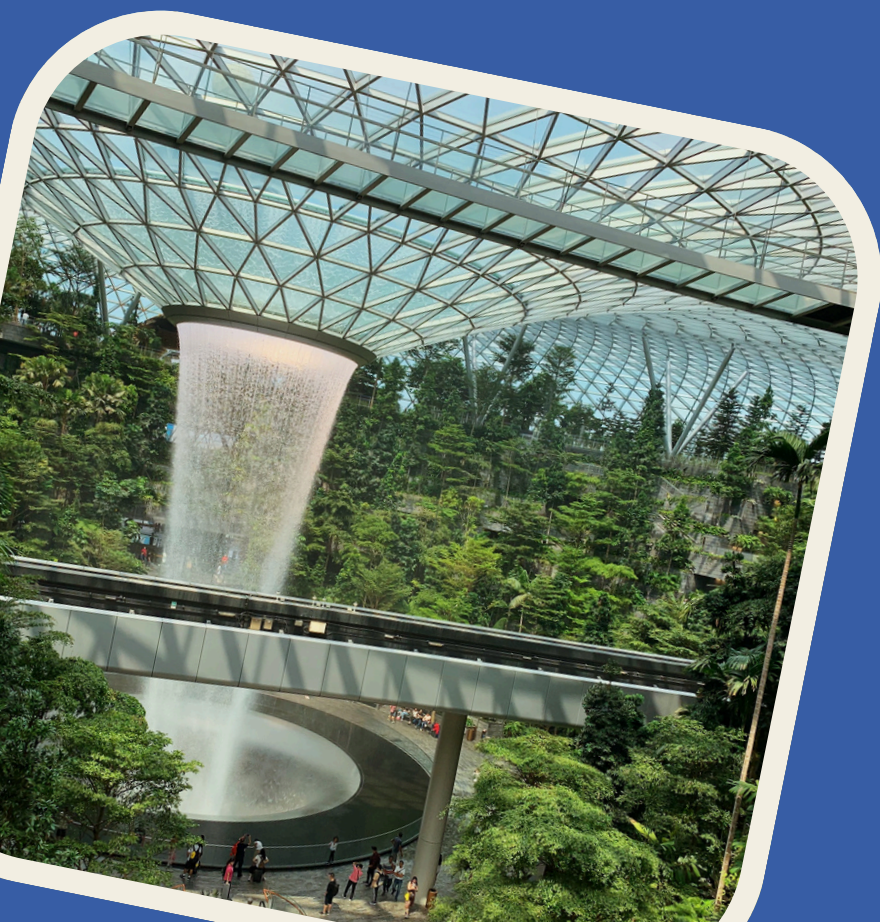
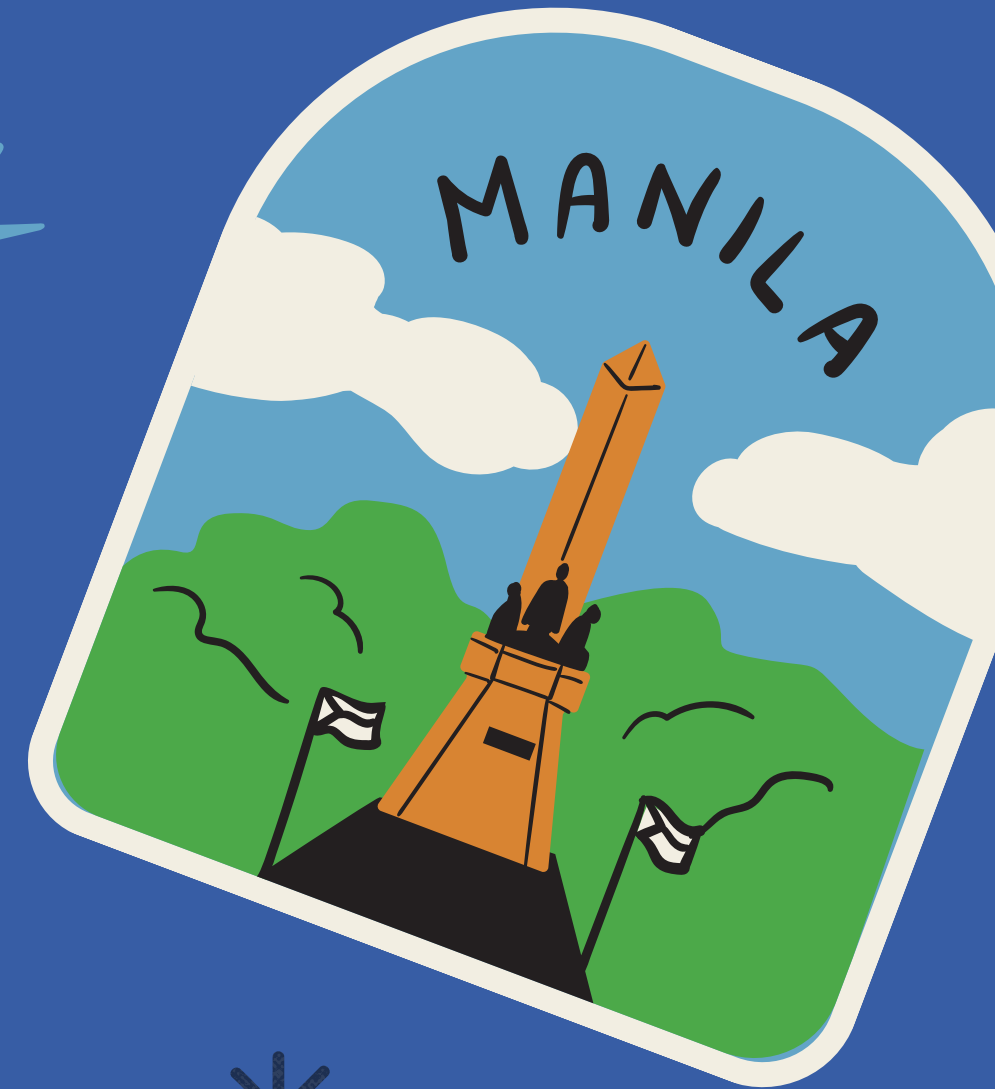




MANILA, PHILIPPINES
